

Transport Safety Fatigue Management Policy

PURPOSE

Clenton's Transport is committed to achieving Heavy Vehicle National Law (HVNL) and Chain of Responsibility (CoR) compliance, and this policy outlines how Clenton's Transport will do all that is reasonably practicable, to ensure safety in all our transport activities in regard to the management of heavy vehicle driver fatigue.

Our Fatigue Management policy and associated procedures are implemented as part of our Transport Safety Management System and maintained to ensure we meet the objectives of HVNL to:

- promote public safety;
- manage the impact of heavy vehicles and the risk to public safety, the environment, road infrastructure and public amenities;
- ensure our business conduct does not directly or indirectly cause or encourage:
 - the driver of the heavy vehicle to contravene the HVNL; or
 - the driver of the heavy vehicle to exceed a speed limit applying to the driver; or
 - another person, including another party in the Chain of Responsibility, to contravene HVNL by eliminating, or minimising where reasonably practicable, all driver fatigue risks arising from our transport activities.

POLICY

Clenton's Transport is committed to eliminating or minimising where reasonably practicable, all driver fatigue related risks associated with our transport activities in accordance with legislative and any scheme-based requirements. We will achieve this by implementing a fatigue management system as part of our risk management program. Our systematic approach identifies hazards in our transport activities, assesses the risks and implements suitable controls in relation to the key risk area of driver fatigue.

We are committed to providing the time, training, resources, and expertise required to conduct all necessary risk management activities including monitoring the ongoing effectiveness of our program.

Through implementation of this policy, Clenton's Transport aims to ensure the safety of our transport activities, ongoing compliance with the HVNL and seek continuous improvement where opportunities arise.

SCOPE

This policy and supporting procedures apply to all Clenton's Transport employees, other persons engaged in our business transport activities and, where applicable, our supply chain partners.

The HVNL Driver Fatigue provisions apply to heavy vehicles with a GVM of more than 12 tonnes.

GOVERNANCE, REVIEW AND CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT

Clenton's Transport will seek continual improvement and compliance with relevant legislation by ensuring all elements of our heavy vehicle driver fatigue risk management program are monitored, reviewed and evaluated on a regular basis in consultation with our employees, contractors, supply chain partners and other relevant duty holders.
