



Transport Safety Roadworthiness Policy

PURPOSE

Clenton's Transport is committed to ensure heavy vehicles do not present a risk to public, community or worker safety. All heavy vehicles must be roadworthy, and workers trained to identify potential risks within their technical capabilities.

Maintenance schedules for heavy vehicles will be developed and implemented to ensure potential risks are minimised **as far as reasonably practicable**.

POLICY

In order to facilitate this Clenton's Transport is committed to ensuring that all our vehicles are maintained in accordance with the agreed maintenance schedules. Where heavy vehicles are owned or operated by third parties, it will be a condition of engagement that records are presented as evidence of adequate maintenance system and adherence with this policy.

Clenton's Transport will also:

- Ensure that roadworthiness compliance is included as a contractual requirement;
- Ensure all vehicles are checked prior to every shift to ensure basic mechanical issues are identified and rectified prior to commencement;
- Investigate any matters that are identified through pre-start or maintenance inspections and rectify any matters that may present a risk to safety;
- Workers are educated on how to conduct a pre-start and on basic heavy vehicle maintenance;
- Workers are provided with regular reminders about the importance of working together to ensure vehicles do not present a risk to the themselves, the public, road infrastructure and the environment a due to poor maintenance or unsafe vehicles. This information will be distributed in accordance with our consultation policy.

SCOPE

This policy and supporting procedures apply to all Clenton's Transport workers, other persons engaged in our business transport activities and, where applicable, our supply chain partners.

GOVERNANCE, REVIEW AND CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT

Clenton's Transport will seek continual improvement and compliance with relevant legislation by ensuring all elements of our CoR risk management program are monitored, reviewed and evaluated on a regular basis in consultation with our workers, contractors, supply chain partners and other relevant duty holders.
