



# Transport Safety Risk Management Policy

## PURPOSE

Clenton's Transport is committed to achieving compliance with the Heavy Vehicle National Law (HVNL) and Chain of Responsibility (CoR) duties and this policy outlines how Clenton's Transport will do all that is reasonably practicable, to ensure safety in all our transport activities.

Clenton's Transport is committed to ensure the operation of heavy vehicles do not present a risk to public, community, employee or contractor safety. All supply chain parties in the CoR and employees must be aware of, effectively manage and control, risks associated with our transport activities.

Our CoR Risk Management policy and procedure is implemented as part of our CoR management system and maintained to ensure we meet the objectives of HVNL to:

- promote public safety;
- manage the impact of heavy vehicles and the risk to public safety, the environment, road infrastructure and public amenity;
- encourage and promote productive, efficient, innovative and safe business practices by eliminating, or minimising where reasonably practicable, all CoR-related risks arising from our transport tasks.

## POLICY

Clenton's Transport is committed to eliminating or minimising where reasonably practicable, all risks associated with our transport activities using a systematic approach to risk management. We will achieve this by implementing a risk management program that identifies hazards, assesses the risks and implements suitable controls in relation to the CoR management areas of mass, dimension, load restraint, fatigue, speed, heavy vehicle safety and road worthiness.

Clenton's Transport is committed to providing the time, training, resources and expertise required to conduct all necessary risk activities including monitoring the ongoing effectiveness

Through implementation of this policy, Clenton's Transport aims to ensure compliance with the HVNL and seek continuous improvement.

## SCOPE

This policy and supporting procedures apply to all Clenton's Transport employees, other persons engaged in our business transport activities and, where applicable, our supply chain partners.

Employees and others will be involved in risk management practices aimed at minimising CoR related safety risks and preventing breaches or incidents.

## GOVERNANCE, REVIEW AND CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT

Clenton's Transport will seek continual improvement and compliance with relevant legislation by ensuring all elements of our CoR risk management program are monitored, reviewed and evaluated on a regular basis in consultation with the employees and contractors, supply chain partners and other relevant duty holders.
