



Transport Safety Policy

PURPOSE

Clenton's Transport is committed to achieving Heavy Vehicle National Law (HVNL) and Chain of Responsibility (CoR) compliance, and this policy outlines how Clenton's Transport will do all that is reasonably practicable, to ensure safety in all our transport activities.

Our Transport Safety policy and management system is implemented and maintained to ensure we meet the objectives of HVNL to:

- promote public safety;
- manage the impact of heavy vehicles on the environment, road infrastructure and public amenities;
- promote industry productivity and efficiency in the road transport of goods and passengers by heavy vehicles; and
- encourage and promote productive, efficient, innovative, and safe business practices.

POLICY

Clenton's Transport is committed to eliminating or minimising where reasonably practicable, all transport-related risks throughout our organisation and associated transport activities and tasks by implementing a Transport Safety Management program that addresses the key risk areas of mass, dimension, load restraint, fatigue, speed and heavy vehicle safety and roadworthiness.

Clenton's Transport is committed to providing the time, resources and expertise required to conduct all necessary activities to prevent hazards arising and incidents and injury/illness occurring in the environments we undertake our transport activities.

Through implementation of this policy, Clenton's Transport aims to ensure the safety of our transport activities, ongoing compliance with the HVNL and seek continuous improvement where opportunities arise.

SCOPE

This policy and supporting procedures apply to all Clenton's Transport's employees, other persons engaged in our business transport activities and, where applicable, our supply chain partners. This includes Registered Operator, Prime Contractor, Transport Operator, Consignor/Consignee, Loading Manager, Loader and Unloader, Scheduler, Packer, and responsible persons.

GOVERNANCE, REVIEW AND CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT

Clenton's Transport will seek continual improvement and compliance with relevant legislation by ensuring all elements of our risk management program are monitored, reviewed, and evaluated on a regular basis in consultation with the employees and contractors, supply chain partners and other relevant duty holders.
